

How to Review Your **Credit Report**

5 important questions to ask yourself while reviewing vour credit report.

1. Is all your personal information correct?

Name, phone #, email address?

2. Is your account status correct?

Are all of your closed accounts recorded as closed?

4. Are all of your accounts listed only once and with the correct creditor?

3. Are all of the dates associated with your account accurate?

5. Are all your balances correct?

[If you answered yes to any of the above, Good Job! Be sure to check your credit report next month. If you answered no, file an inquiry and freeze your account.]
