FEE CHANGES

Good news effective August 1st!

We have eliminated the following fees:

- IRA Dormancy Fee \$5.00
- Account Closure Fee (if closed within 6 months of opening) \$20.00
- Account Re-Opening Fee \$5.00

Also, the Overdraft Transfer Fee of \$5.00 will now be \$3.00 per transfer!
